The mystery event will be.....CHARIOT RACES

Between the time the mystery event is released (4pm April 14th) to the time of the event (5pm April 17th) each Greek Week pairing must make a chariot, and they will be raced on the event date.

Rules for Chariot Building

- Each pairing must have their own chariot
- Any material can be used (be creative)
- NO artificial power can be used, only human power can move the chariot this means NO cars, scooters, four wheelers or anything that has a motor.
- If it has wheels, when it is freestanding (no one holding it up) all wheels must be on the ground
- One person must be able to fit into the chariot and the chariot must be stable and able to move with that person inside it.
- Chariots can be any size

*Bonus points will be given based on the most creative/decorative chariot

Wednesday at 5pm all chariots should be in their assigned spot at Parker Field (there will be a sign with your chapters names on it) and we will decide whose

chariot is most creative. Based on Blood Drive results a bracket will be set up and races will begin.

Race Rules

- The teams that get first and second place in blood drive percentages will get a bye for the first race and will automatically go to the second round of races.
- It will be a single elimination tournament
- The race will be to the finish line as marked
- Two people at most can move the chariot, and one person must ride inside (3 people total)
- No handheld Chariots
- Winner will be determined by when the first part of the chariot has crossed the finish line
- Teams will not know who or what order they are racing until the event
- All races will be timed and recorded, after all races the chariot that had the fastest time overall out of all of the races will earn bonus points (this is not necessarily the person who wins first place)
- Once races are over and fastest and creative chariots points are added, we will announce the winner (This means if you do not win, but your chariot is the most creative and fastest you could still get first place)
- Absolutely NO getting in other chariots lanes or pushing each other during the race
- Only two chariots will race at a time for safety reasons

If chariots are late arriving to the location, or any of the rules are broken, all chapters associated with that chariot will be disqualified and will receive no points.

POINTS

- 2nd Place- 15 points
- 3rd Place- 10 points
- 4th Place- 10 points
- 5th Place- 10 points
- 6th Place- 10 points
